

EGHS ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION 2009-2010 IMPORTANT INFORMATION revised 6/12/09

I. Athletic Participation Requirements

A physical, also called the New Certificate of Health, and an Athletic Permit is required from every student athlete, every new school year. Students who are going out for ANY athletic team, (doesn't matter the season), must have these two forms (Certificate of Health and Athletic Permit completed and on file before the first practice. Both of these forms are available on our web site <http://eghs.d214.org>. The physical is returned to our school nurse, Mrs. Kathie Sczepanski, and the Athletic permit is returned to Mrs. O' Malley in the Athletic Office. After these forms are returned, students are given an "Athletic White Card" (on the Athletic White Card Pick Up Dates - see Section IV) to give their coach. The card signifies the athlete's readiness to begin practice. Students must be registered for school, before a white card can be given.

II. Current Certificate of Child Health Exam Form – the Physical Form

This certificate is only current within 12 months prior to entering 9th grade. It must be current through to the end of the season in which the student is participating. It must be signed and stamped by the examining physician. Be sure to make a copy for your own records, before sending it to our school nurse, Mrs. Kathie Sczepanski. Return to our nurse by July 15th for fall sports. Do not send physicals to the Athletic Office. Every physician has these forms and they are also on our web site <http://eghs.d214.org>.

III. Athletic Permit

The Athletic permit form must be signed by the parent and the student every new school year confirming that the IHSA eligibility and the District 214 Co-curricular Code is understood. (downloadable from eghs website). Return this form please by July 15th to Deanna O'Malley in the Athletic Office.

IV. Join the Grenadier Athletic Boosters – Every family of an athlete – Please join the Grenadier Athletic Boosters.

Yearly family membership is \$25.00. You'll be able to pay this when you register online. If you have multiple children at EGHS, it is only necessary to pay the \$25.00 once. If you wish to "pay again" with a second child's registration, your contribution will be accepted as a donation to the GAB and will be acknowledged as such for tax purposes. With your \$25.00 membership, 2009-2010 Athletic Grenadier Athletic Booster Club Members will receive two tickets that can be used for admittance to any home game (non tournament game) and a *School Team Finder*, a directory with directions to any site where athletic contests are hosted.

V. Grades 9 – 12 – Athletic White Card Pick UP and also the day for . . .

Grades 10 – 12 Pick Up for schedules, ID's, academic planners, etc.

Students grades 9 – 12 will pick up their Athletic White Card (which allows the student to begin practice in their fall sport) on one of the above dates. And in addition, with a new process this year, students Grades 10 – 12 will pick up their schedules, I.D.'s, academic planners, bus stop info., etc.) on one of these dates. Grade 9 students and parents get this same info on August 19th when they arrive for their mandatory evening transition program. (Arrive by 6:40 p.m for the 7:00 p.m. program.)

Athletic White Card and Grade 10 – 12 Important Materials Pick Up Dates

Monday, August 10 – 8:00 – 2:00 p.m.

Tuesday, August 11 – 12 noon – 8:00 p.m.

Wednesday, August 12 - 8:00 – 2:00

Note: Fall Athletic season begins on Wednesday, August 12th – Registration fees, all obligations and physicals must be taken care of before any student can begin practicing for the fall season.

VI. Elk Grove Village and Des Plaines Athletic Practice Bus Schedule, Routes, and Stops
