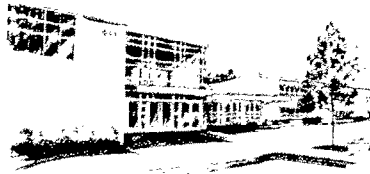

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to the beginning of the new school year. We know. We know. The last year has just ended, and you're getting set to enjoy summer. But we want to give you plenty of notice about what's happening in August so you will be ready for another year of challenges and successes.

The attached packet contains the information you will need to have your student be prepared for school and fall athletics. There are several points which we would like to emphasize:

- The online registration and fee payment site opens on June 15th and payment and registration must be completed by July 31st. Families applying for a fee waiver, must do so on Saturday, June 27th between the hours of 8:00 and 1:00 p.m. Fee waiver required documentation is detailed in the attached information packet.
- All families need to provide us with an email address and working phones. Do this as you update information with your 09-10 online fee payment. Next year, email, will be the primary, and often the only way, we communicate with you. For various reasons, we will not use US postal mail very frequently.
- Class schedules, bus routes, IDs, etc. will NOT be mailed to our students. Instead –
 - Sophomores, juniors, and seniors must pick up their materials at school on August 10th, 11th, or 12th. Times are noted in the attached document. Athletic "White Cards" will be available on those same days so a separate trip isn't necessary.
 - Freshmen schedules, bus route info, ID's etc. will be distributed at the required beginning of the year freshmen student/parent meeting on August 19th at 7:00 p.m. Grade 9 students also required to attend the required Freshmen Transition (GROWTH program) day, which is scheduled for Thursday, August 20th
- Physicals for incoming freshmen, transfer students, and for fall athletes are due no later than July 15, 2009. It is critical that you address this issue immediately. If your incoming freshman does not yet have his/her appointment for a physical, please contact the doctor's office to set up an appointment. Yearly updated physicals are also required for any student participating in athletics. So if your child is planning to play a fall sport, plan to get his/her physical in by July 15th at the latest. Contact the Student Services office at 847-718-4422 to get information on free and reduced price physical examination information
- All freshmen will have a half-day of school on August 20th. This experience is important and mandatory. Buses will run the regular bus schedule. Students, grades 10 – 12 start on Wednesday, August 26.
- Freshmen parents and students are asked to attend a mandatory Freshmen Student/Parent meeting on Wednesday, August 19th at 7:00 p.m. Please arrive by 6:40 a.m. to pick up schedules and important information.

The attached guide has more complete information on these and a wide variety of other topics to help you prepare your child ready for the 2009-2010 school year. Please study it carefully and retain this information for further reference.

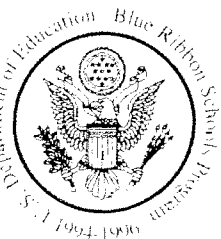
