

## **What is Advisory?**

### **Advisory creates connections....**

Incoming and new students are assigned to an advisor who will be their adult connection to Elk Grove High School. Advisories, made up of sixteen 9th through 12th graders, is designed to provide a community where older students can mentor younger students.

### **Advisory builds community...**

Students remain in the same advisory for their duration at EGHS. Advisors receive copies of student grade reports, discuss progress with students, assist students with academics, and hold team-building activities. This is also a place where the daily announcements are heard, and other "business" is taken care of.

### **Advisory is a regular part of the school day and a key piece of every student's schedule...**

Advisories meet daily for the first 16 minutes of the day on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. Advisories also meet on Thursdays for the first 20 minutes of the day. Attendance is mandatory.

### **Advisory is a place to get information....**

There may be specific meetings held during advisory time to give a particular group information. For example, counselors hold informational meetings for each grade prior to course selection.
