

# EGHS ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION 2017-2018 IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## **I. Physical Requirement**

A physical, also called the *Certificate of Health*, is required from every student athlete, every new school year. The physical is returned to our school nurse, Mrs. Kathie Szczepanski. After the physical is turned in and the student is verified to be registered for the school year, they can pick up their "Athletic White Card" (on the Athletic White Card Pick Up Dates - see Section V) and give their coach. The card signifies the athlete's readiness to begin practice.

## **II. Current Certificate of Child Health Exam Form – the Physical Form**

This certificate is only current within 12 months prior to entering 9th grade. It must be current through to the end of the season which the student is participating. It must be signed and stamped by the examining physician. Be sure to make a copy for your own records, before sending it to our school nurse, Mrs. Kathie Szczepanski. Every physician has these forms.

## **III. Athletic Permit**

Athletic Parent Consent is part of the online registration process. If not signed off during registration, hard copies are available at White Card Pick-Up days for parent/student signature.
