

IMPORTANT MESSAGE REGARDING ENTRANCE INTO SCHOOL FOR YOUR FRESHMAN STUDENT IN AUGUST 2018

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- ❖ **The physical is due no later than June 1, 2018.** The new physical form can be found on the school website. Families who turn in physicals after June 1st may experience a slight delay in obtaining their child's schedule when the Infinite Campus portal opens on August 4th.
- ❖ Bring in the physical to the Main office or Student Services. Physicals can also be faxed to the nurse office at 847-718-4562. The main office and student services is open all summer Mon. – Thurs. 7:00am – 4:00pm. **Incomplete physicals will be returned.**
- ❖ District 214 Board of Education enforces a **first day exclusion policy**. If the physical is not completed, including physician signature and stamp, immunizations, and **health history section completed by parent with a signature, your student will not be able to start school.**
- ❖ **We send students home until this is all complete.**
- ❖ **All students will be required to show proof of a Tdap vaccine for Pertussis or “whooping cough,” two doses of varicella vaccine for chickenpox, or proof of disease documented on physical form by a physician prior to the first day of school as required by the Illinois Dept. of Public Health, and two doses of MMR (measles, mumps, rubella).**

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION

- ❖ **NO SCHEDULES or iPADS will be issued to students at freshmen orientation until the nurse reviews and checks in the completed physical.**

PHYSICALS AND IMMUNIZATIONS – Where to Go:

- ❖ Your child's regular doctor.
- ❖ There is a list of low-cost clinics in our area on the school website or you can obtain from the school nurse or main office.

CHRONIC MEDICAL CONDITIONS

- ❖ If your child has a **chronic medical condition**, please call me so we can come up with a plan to assist them in their learning.
